Instructions:

Think about your ideal career using these 5 elements as a guide. Enter a description in each of the boxes. Try to be as specific and as clear as possible. This is not about what you 'could' do given your past skills and experience or what you 'should' do. It's about the <u>ideal.</u> The clearer you can get on what it is you really want, the easier it will be to recognize it when it appears and it will also allow you to spend time and energy efficiently pursuing opportunities that fit the criteria. Next, rank in order which element is most important to you: i.e. Work = #1, Location = #2 etc. This will be important to get clear on what you value the most. In some cases you may be assessing opportunities that could involve making some tradeoffs, so knowing your priorities is key. Finally, take a step back and ask yourself, 1) does this sound like an amazing opportunity that I would LOVE to do and would take in a heartbeat? And then 2) what do I need to do to make this ideal career become a reality?
